1. Introduction

This document is a summary report of the joint events where joint participation or organisation by EOSC-hub and OpenAIRE-Advance was conducted in an effort to reach common stakeholders. These events were conducted in the second half of the duration of the EOSC-hub/OpenAIRE-Advance Collaboration Agreement (CA).

The purpose of this summary report is to assess the effectiveness of the joint events carried out by the two projects in the context of this Collaboration Agreement.

The present document is organized through the following:

- Section 2 provides an overview of all the events where EOSC-hub and OpenAIRE-Advance jointly-organised participation in or events that were jointly organised by the two projects. Information on the estimated reach and impact.
- Section 2.1 is a showcase of some snapshots from the events.
- Section 2.2 provides an overview of the joint communication materials developed for the events.
- Finally, Session 3 draws some conclusions.

Overall, EOSC-hub and OpenAIRE-Advance organised a total of seven events (including one postponed for January 2021). The COVID-19 pandemic, has had a significant impact on the number of events organised within 2020, but despite this, the two projects have managed to still engage the most relevant stakeholders at a crucial time in the development of EOSC and the stage at which the projects were at.

2. Overview of Joint Events: M19-M36

This reporting period was characterised by the increased maturity of the two projects with the majority of the projects' results being brought forward. At the same time, the environment in which the two projects operate, the EOSC ecosystem, has started to see further consolidation of efforts with national and thematic EOSC clusters gaining momentum and the need to coordinate and synergise with other relevant initiatives, especially the developing EOSC governance structure, has become more important.

This meant a need to share the projects' results jointly, particularly the outcome of its collaborations. The joint EOSC-hub-OpenAIRE-Advance calendar was targeted both to those familiar with EOSC as well as the wider European research community leading the work on advancing open science and FAIR-isation of research data. It also meant the need to meet other EOSC projects, key players of the EOSC governance and ensuring that outputs of both projects are taken up by them.

While the event calendar was rich with engagements and has achieved to tackle the points from the first paragraph, particularly in the first half of this reporting period, the COVID-19 pandemic significantly affected the organisation of events for the second half of this reporting

period. Towards November 2020 onwards, this slightly recovered due to increased opportunities through virtual events.

Finally, the event Open Science FAIR: Journey to EOSC: Preparing at National Level ensured that both projects were in tune with the latest developments in the EOSC landscape particularly in the consolidation of efforts towards the development of EOSC at national levels.
